At the Lions International Convention in 1925, Helen Keller challenged all Lions to dedicate themselves as Knights of the Blind in the Crusade against darkness. The Lions accepted that challenge, and from that day forward, the primary mission of the Lions around the world has been to prevent blindness. The Lions of Alabama, in cooperation with Lions Clubs International, established a memorial at Ivy Green, the birthplace of Helen Keller.
